



Fire prevention

Stavely Minerals takes fire preparedness and prevention very seriously. An ex-CFA Fire Brigade Captain, with more than 30 years' experience as an active firefighter, is on staff.

Preparation for the Fire Danger Period:

- Weather forecasts are monitored and CFA warnings factored into all planned activities. On days of Total Fire Ban and Machinery Stop Work, there will be no drilling, maintenance or movement of drill rigs, no vehicle movement in paddocks, and all drilling personnel leave site for the duration of the ban.
- All drilling rigs are equipped with fire suppression units that can be engaged in case of fire. In addition to this, numerous fire extinguishers are placed around the drill sites.
- A dedicated firefighting trailer is located in the vicinity of the drill rigs.
- All vehicles are diesel-powered and carry a fire extinguisher.
- Stavely Minerals' Fire Response and Readiness Plan is set by the operating standard required by Licence Conditions, under the Code of Practice for Mineral Exploration and relevant legislation.
